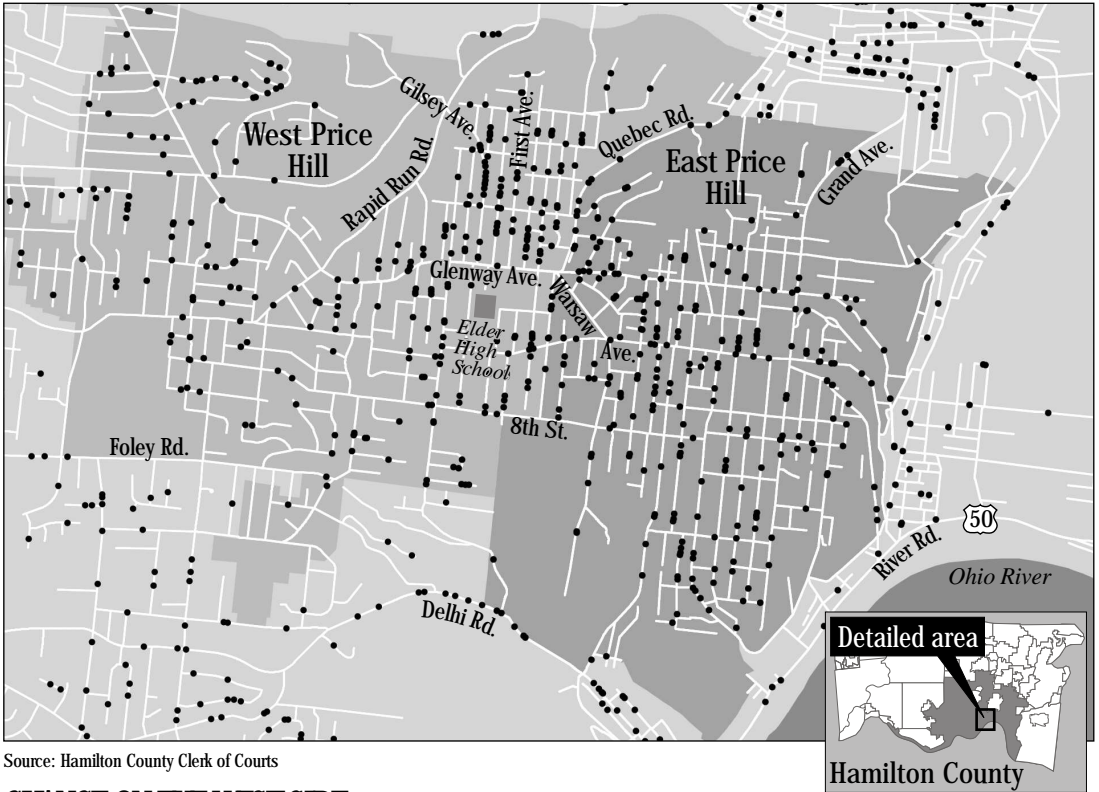


PRICE HILL: FORECLOSURE LEADER
