

Schools that missed their goals

These 24 schools in Northern Kentucky did not meet all of their goals for improving test scores under the No Child Left Behind Act. Each school has overall goals for reading and math, along with

goals for distinct groups of students. To be considered a group, such students must number at least 10 in the grade level being tested, or 30 for the total school.
